Protection for Unvaccinated Agricultural Field Workers

Masks and Frequent Hygiene Measures

- Wear a mask until you're fully vaccinated to help reduce the spread of COVID-19.
- Wear a mask correctly. It should cover your nose and mouth and be changed frequently.
- Frequently wash your hands with soap and water or use a hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.



Protection Against COVID-19 in Agriculture Work Sites

- Place safety and informational posters about COVID-19 in places that are visible to your workers.
- The posters should indicate safety measures for unvaccinated workers: wearing a mask, staying at least 6 feet apart, handwashing, and avoiding crowds and poorly ventilated areas.
- Encourage your workers to get vaccinated. COVID-19 vaccines are safe, available, and free, regardless of your immigration or health insurance status.

What to Do if Someone Is Sick

- Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms should stay at home and isolated from everyone else with whom they share housing.
- The employer should communicate worker's positive COVID-19 cases to local health authorities.
